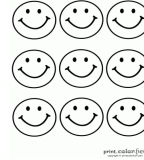

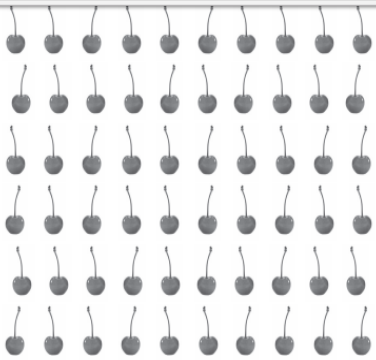

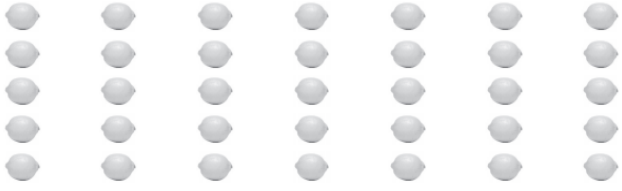

So he started barking at his own reflection. His bone fell in water as soon as he opened his mouth. The greedy dog lost his bone.

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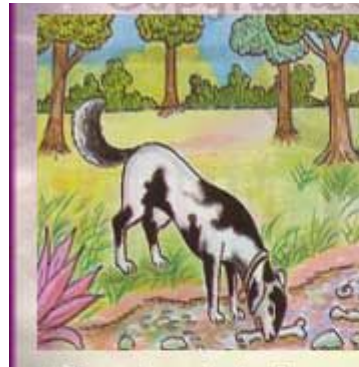
